Ticket Sales – Terms & Conditions

(Fundraising Event – Non-Profit Community Organisation)

These Terms & Conditions apply to all tickets purchased for **Festa Junina 2026 – XII Arraiá dos Brasileirinhos**, held on **18 July 2026**, from **11am to 5pm**, at **Te Atatū Peninsula Community Centre**, Auckland.

By purchasing a ticket, you agree to the following:

1. Nature of the Event

- Festa Junina 2026 is a **fundraising event** organised by **Brasileirinhos Aotearoa New Zealand**, a **non-profit community organisation**.
 - All contributions received through ticket sales are treated as **donations** supporting our cultural, educational, and community programmes.

2. Ticket Types & Suggested Donation Amounts

- **Adults:** Suggested donation \$20
- **Members:** Suggested donation \$10
- **Children under 14:** Suggested donation \$5
- **Members' children:** Free (optional donation encouraged)

These amounts are **suggested donations** to support the event and our community work.

3. Limited Capacity

- Entry is only guaranteed with a valid ticket.
 - Once capacity is reached, no additional tickets will be issued.
 - Tickets must be presented at the entrance (digital or printed).

4. Refunds & Cancellations

Because this is a **fundraising event**, all ticket purchases are treated as **donations**.

- **Tickets are non-refundable**, including for change of mind or inability to attend.
- If the event is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control (e.g., venue closure, severe weather, public health restrictions), Brasileirinhos Aotearoa may:
 - reschedule the event, or
 - convert all tickets into donations supporting our programmes.

No refunds will be issued.

5. Event Changes

Brasileirinhos Aotearoa reserves the right to make changes to the event programme, schedule, or activities if required for safety, operational, or logistical reasons.

6. Alcohol-Free & Smoke-Free Event

To ensure a safe, family-friendly environment:

- No alcohol is permitted on site.
 - No smoking or vaping is allowed anywhere inside or outside the venue during the event.

7. Health & Safety

- All attendees must follow instructions from event staff and volunteers.
 - Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.
 - Unsafe behaviour may result in removal from the event without refund.

8. Photography & Media

- Photos and videos may be taken during the event for community documentation and promotional purposes.
 - By attending, you consent to the use of images that may include you or your family.
 - If you prefer not to be photographed, please inform a volunteer at the entrance.

9. Personal Belongings

Brasileirinhos Aotearoa is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to personal items brought to the event.

10. Food & Allergies

- Food items offered at the event are **donated** by families and community supporters.
 - While we aim to label ingredients where possible, we **cannot guarantee allergen-free food**.
 - Attendees with allergies must exercise caution.
